

PRINTING *and* ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


1. In your printer settings, select the double-sided printing option, making sure that the pages are in landscape orientation and aligned so that the contents do not flip upside down when appearing on the reverse side of the page.
2. Print the six journal pages. There will be three total pieces of paper (excluding this instructions page; do not print this).
3. Stack the three pieces of paper according to the diagram at the right.
4. Fold the stack of papers in half. This will create a booklet.
5. Staple along the center fold line to bind your pages, if desired.






